### The Theory and Practice of Engaged Knowledge Co-production



**Presenter: Dr. Christine Kirchhoff**

Dr. Kirchhoff is an Associate Professor in Civil and Environmental Engineering at the University of Connecticut and is an affiliated faculty member with the Connecticut Institute for Resilience and Climate Adaptation and with the Department of Natural Resources and the Environment. In 2020, she received the honorary title of Castleman Professor in Engineering Innovation and was awarded an NSF CAREER grant.

Dr. Kirchhoff's research focuses on the social studies of science, technology and public policy; the science of actionable knowledge; water governance, management, and regulatory compliance; and, the human dimensions of resilience, especially of water and wastewater infrastructure.

**Abstract:** Her presentation will discuss the theory and practice of knowledge co-production as a means of engaging stakeholders in the production of actionable information as well as the future directions and challenges in co-production including how to scale-up co-production using in-person versus remote engagement.
